About this workshop:

Why does the widely held idea of a decent life – home, contribution to others, friends and interesting things to do, seem harder to achieve for some people? What if person centred planning just results in more of the same? Is there a way to work creatively and effectively that actually achieves better lives for people?

This workshop is an introduction to Social Role Valorisation (SRV). SRV is designed to create a deeper awareness of the circumstances of people who are marginalised by society (including those with significant disability, those who are ageing, in poverty and/or homeless) and key factors for making a positive difference. Participants will explore:

- How individuals, human services and our society contribute to marginalising people
- Valued social roles as a potent catalyst for change and the foundation of a much better life for those we care about.

Who is this workshop for?

This workshop is designed for participants from a range of sectors (disability, education, aged care, mental health, youth, etc.) If you are seeking ways to meet the real needs of marginalised individuals and are a support worker, teacher, coordinator, advocate, family member, person with disability or an older person receiving services, then this workshop has particular relevance.

It is a workshop for those wanting to learn more about SRV – a powerful framework that will sustain, focus, and energise participants working in a person centred way to actually achieve much better – a good life for those served.
